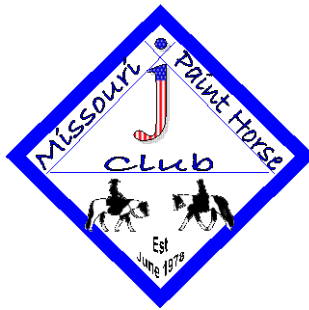


MjPHC APRIL 2010 NEWSLETTER
