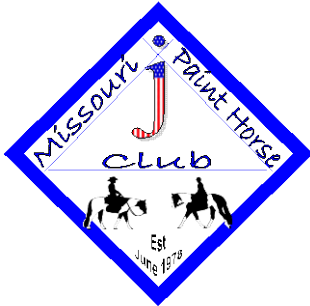


MJPHC FEBRUARY 2010 NEWSLETTER

MjPHC to Host Show Clinic – April 10th and 11th, 2010

On the weekend of April 10th and 11th, 2010, the MJPHC will be hosting a show clinic. The clinic will be conducted by Joe Frank Brown, of Gladewater, Texas. Mr. Brown owns and operates Joe Frank Brown Show Horses, which specializes in training all around APHA youth exhibitors. Both Mr. Brown and his clients have earned numerous World and Reserve World titles, as well as top two riders in the nation and several top five.

On Saturday, the clinic will run from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm for Showmanship. After a one hour lunch break, the clinic will then pick up again at 1:30 pm and last until 5:30 pm, and will focus on Horsemanship, Hunt Seat Equitation, and Rail Work. On Sunday, the clinic will run from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm and will be dedicated to Competitive (Show) Trail. The clinic will be held at Misty Rivers Equestrian Center, in Independence, Missouri. Misty Rivers is a boarding stable situated on approximately fifty-five acres of land. The amenities include two indoor arenas, an outdoor arena, fifty stalls, a round pen, large pastures, and much more. A limited number of stalls with shavings included are available if stalling is preferred over trailering in and out. Spectators are welcome for the small fee of ten dollars for the weekend. The recommended hotel, LaQuinta Inn, is located in Blue Springs, Missouri. A flyer is included listing prices, exact location, and an application form. Space for riders in the clinic is limited; please send in your applications by April 1st if you wish to ride in the clinic.
