"We have a great group of youngsters showing Paints," stated Youth Adviser Sue Hilton, "and our youth members wanted to encourage and challenge each other to lend a hand, welcome new exhibitors and be of service, in general, during the year...to go above and beyond." Adults only will have the opportunity to nominate a Youth exhibitor who has displayed exemplary service to the Club, its members and visitors during 2010. If you meet the eligibility requirements for the \$25.00 stall fee over Labor Day, you will also meet the requirements for eligibility for one of two work saddles. One horse/one rider must show in halter in a maximum of two divisions. For example: A novice youth can show in novice youth and/or Youth and/or Open: a youth can show in Youth and Open; a novice amateur can show in Novice Amateur and/or Amateur and/or Open; an amateur can show in Amateur and Open. The eligibility list will be posted on the website. Thank you to Robbie Rainer and Chariton Vet Supply who worked with Olin Parker in obtaining these two saddles.

There will also be awards for Grands and Reserves, Class Champions, High Points and Reserve High Points for Open, Novice Amateur, Amateur, Youth Walk-Trot, Novice Youth and Youth. **YOU MUST SIGN UP FOR HIGH POINT AWARDS** at the entry booth.

Zone 5 Team Tournament Rules

1. Entry Fee \$75.00 per team. Will include a free T-shirt for each participating team member
2. Team members & Class Entries must be named by November 1, along with the number of t-shirts needed and sizes. Each state in the Zone will have only one team.
3. Team members can earn points in all youth classes (Walk Trot, Novice Youth, Youth 18 and under) Walk-Trot: Showmanship-Hunter Under Saddle- Equitation- W. Pleasure- Horsemanship-Trail Novice: Showmanship-Hunter under Saddle-Equitation- W. Pleasure -Horsemanship-Trail Youth 18 & Under: Showmanship-Hunter under Saddle-Equitation-W. Pleasure-Horsemanship-Trail
4. Each Team can have a total of 4 entries in each 18 and under class with no more than 2 entries in each age division, or 2 entries in each class that is split by age:
4. Novice Youth classes may have no more than 2 entries ages 13 and under and no more than 2 entries ages 14-18;
 - a. Youth 18 & Under class, each team may have no more than 2 entries that are 13 and under and no more than 2 entries that are 14-18;
 - b. Each team may have no more than 4 entries in any Walk-Trot class.
5. Stall Decorating is encouraged and points will be given to those that participate.
6. A Knowledge Relay will be held on Saturday night during the Barrel and Pole classes, with points being given to each participating team. Five youth from each team will participate with at least one participant from each age group being a member of the team if the team has members in each age group (5-9, 13 and Under, 14-18); scoring will be determined by the fastest time.
7. Each member of the top winning team will receive a jacket (courtesy of the Zone committee) with the Zone 5 logo.
