This year, MPHC, in conjunction with the KPHC, will put on the 40th Anniversary World Wide Paint Horse Congress, July 29-31, to be held at the American Royal Complex in Kansas City, Missouri. Once again, showing in Missouri continues to be a bargain in comparison to other states. MPHC extends a cordial invite to members outside of Missouri to come to our shows. You won't be disappointed!

REGISTRATION PAPERS AND MEMBERSHIP CARDS

Just a reminder that this year you will be required to show your registration and memberships cards as required by APHA rules SC-160A and C. In addition, you will be required to leave a signed check at the entry booth prior to showing. Please note the following rules:

SC-160 A. ELIGIBILITY TO SHOW. All exhibitors must possess a current APHA/AjPHA membership in order to show in APHA approved classes. Show management must inspect the current card, legible photocopy of the current card or a temporary card at each show.

SC-160 C. REGISTRATION PAPER INSPECTION. Show management must inspect the registration certificate or photocopy of registration certificate of each horse entered in an approved class. Entries shall be made in the name of the recorded owner.

SEND COPIES OF YOUR HORSE

If you want to get a head start on the show entering process, send a copy of your horse registration certificate and your APHA membership card to Show Secretary Julie Engelbrecht now. *TIME TO PAY YOUR 2011
MEMBERSHIP DUES !*

Don't forget that your 2011 membership fees are now due. Dues may be paid by check payable to MPHC. If paid by cash, it is the responsibility of the member to obtain and retain a paid receipt until a 2011 membership card is issued. Membership applications and Horse Nomination forms are available on the MPHC website. Please send your membership application and horse nomination forms to the attention of Clea Bobbitt, 18 Short Road, Eldon, MO 65026.

The 2011 fees are \$30.00 for a family (husband, wife and children under 19), farm, ranch, corporation or partnership. Individual youth (18 and under) dues are \$10.00. Life memberships are available at \$200.00.

In the case of joint ownership, a joint membership must be obtained in both owners' names. If you have a leased horse, the lessee must be a member and the lease must be filed with the APHA in accordance with APHA rule RG-085.

It is the member's responsibility to see that their dues are recorded properly with the MPHC. The MPHC will not be held responsible for an exhibitor's failure to pay their membership.

QUALIFICATIONS AND NOMINATION FEE

To qualify for Year-End Awards (Class and All-Around High Point), all owners must be MPHC members in good standing and must obtain a membership in the owner's name / names as appears on the horse's APHA registration papers.

To be eligible for Year-End Awards, a per horse nomination fee of \$10.00 is required if paid on or before June 1; thereafter, \$30.00. The last opportunity to nominate for Year End Awards: **August 14, 2011**. All points earned prior to the nomination fee and membership dues being paid will not count for Year-End Awards.

APHA NATIONAL DIRECTOR VOTER REGISTRATION

The APHA National Director voter registration postcards will be mailed on March 21st. The MPHC national director nominees are Lisa Maxwell and Olin Parker. Online voting begins March 24th and ends at midnight on May 2nd. Vote at www.aphaonline.org/vote.
