These classes will include Cutting, Reining, Roping and Working Cow Horse. Team Sorting and Team Penning will also be featured.

BEST IN STATE

Congratulations to our MjPHC members Nicole Bricker, Alyssa Reynolds, Lindsey Valdiviez and Lauren Ashton on their impressive accomplishments in 4-H. These girls are an exemplary example of the fine youth who belong to the Missouri Junior Paint Horse Club.

The Jackson County 4-H Senior Horse Bowl Team placed 1st in the State Horse Bowl Competition held in Columbia, MO on Saturday April 18, 2009. Horse Bowl is a team competition which requires extensive knowledge of the horse in 12 categories including; 1) feeds and nutrition 2) breeding, genetics, and reproduction 3) anatomy 4) physiology 5) history and evolution 6) breeds, breed associations, colors and markings 7) training and psychology 8) horse showing 9) diseases and unsoundnesses 10) parasitology 11) horse judging, conformation and gaits and 12) tack, equipment, and housing. Four team members compete against four team members from each other participating county using buzzers and strict time constraints.

The winning Jackson County Senior Team (age requirement 14-18) consisted of: Nicole Bricker, Halle Wild, Alyssa Reynolds and Alex Alford. On an individual basis Nicole Bricker ranked 1st, Halle Wild ranked 3rd and Alyssa Reynolds ranked 7th in the state. This team will represent Missouri in the Eastern National Competition in Louisville, Kentucky, November, 7th 2009.

The Jackson County Junior Horse Bowl Team (age requirement 8-13) placed 2nd in the state. The Junior Team consisted of Lindsey Valdiviez, Haley Bruns, Erica Maize, Kylie Maize, and Mckayla Dickerson. On an individual basis Lindsey Valdiviez placed 2nd in the state.

The Jackson County 4-H Hippology Team also placed 1st in the State Hippology Competition held in Columbia, MO on Sunday April 19, 2009. Hippology is also a competition which requires extensive knowledge of the 12 categories listed above. In this competition knowledge is demonstrated by each individual identifying specific information from 125 unknown slides, taking a 50 question multiple choice test, judging 2 horse classes, and solving a hypothetical horse related problem as a team.

The winning Jackson County Senior Team consisted of Halle Wild, Alyssa Reynolds, Alex Alford, and Lauren Ashton. On an individual basis Halle Wild ranked 1st and Alyssa Reynolds ranked 3rd in the state.

The Jackson County Junior Hippology Team placed 3rd in the state. The Junior Team

consisted of Lindsey Valdiviez, Haley Bruns, Erica Maize and Kylie Maize. On an individual basis, Lindsey Valdiviez ranked 1st in the state.
