

2018 MPHC MEMBERSHIP AND AWARDS POLICY

1. Dues may be paid by check payable to the MPHC. If paid by cash, it is the responsibility of the member to obtain and retain a paid receipt until a **2018** membership card is issued. It is the member's responsibility to see that their dues are recorded properly with the MPHC. The MPHC will not be held responsible for an exhibitor's failure to pay their membership.
2. **2018** dues are \$30.00 for a family (husband, wife and children under 19), farm, ranch, corporation or partnership. Individual youth (18 and under) dues are \$10.00. Life memberships are available at \$200.00.
3. In the case of joint ownership, a joint membership must be obtained in both owners' names.
4. In the case of leased horses, the lessee must be a member and the lease must be filed with the APHA in accordance with paragraph RG-140 - Leases of the APHA Rule Book.

QUALIFICATIONS AND NOMINATION FEE

1. To qualify for Year End Awards (Class and All Around High Point), all owners must be MPHC members in good standing and must obtain a membership in the owner's name(s) as appears on the horse's APHA registration papers.
2. To be eligible for Year End Awards, a per horse nomination fee of **\$20.00** is required and payable on or before June 1, 2018. Thereafter the nomination fee will be \$60.00.
3. All points earned prior to the nomination fee and membership dues being paid will not count for Year End Awards.

STATE POINTS

1. Points will be calculated on a 6-5-4-3-2-1 basis in a class of six (6) or more horses, not to exceed six (6) points for first place. Example: In a class of four (4) horses points would be 4-3-2-1.
2. No points will be awarded to a disqualified horse, but points will be awarded on the basis of the number of horses exhibited.

WEEKEND ALL AROUND HIGH POINT AWARDS AND OVERALL HALTER HORSE

Exhibitors must sign up for weekend High Point Awards at each show.

Membership and nomination requirements are waived for weekend All Around High Point Awards.

1. **Must be** a MPHC member and nomination horse in order to "bank" the weekend award earned.
2. **Open, Open SPB** – Horse must compete in halter and in at least three (3) performance classes per day.
3. **Amateur Walk/Trot, Novice Amateur, Amateur, SPB Amateur - (1 horse/1 rider)** - Horse **must** compete in halter and at least three (3) performance classes per day.
4. **3. Youth Walk/Trot, Novice Youth, Youth 13/under, Youth 14-18, SPB Youth** - (1 horse/1 rider) – Horse **must** compete in halter and at least three (3) performance classes per day.
5. **Overall Open Halter (Mare, Gelding, Stallion)** – Will be calculated as follows: Horse with most Grands, then Reserves. If a tie exists it will be broken by the tie breaker judges selected by show management at the beginning of the show.
 - a. For example, Horse A received 2 Grands and 2 Reserves and Horse B received 1 Grand and 2 Reserves. Horse A would be the overall Halter Horse.

YEAR END CLASS AND ALL AROUND HIGH POINT AWARDS

The Zone 5 show will count for "points only" for MPHC year-end awards, it will **NOT** count toward the # of judges requirement.

Class Awards

1. All divisions (Open, Open SPB, Amateur W/T, Nov Am, Am, SPB Am, Youth W/T, Nov Youth, Youth 13/U, Youth 14-18, SPB Youth) must compete in a class as follows: Must show to 80% of the judges offered for 2018 (most of the classes there will be 20 judges available so you must show to 16 judges).
2. Awards will be given for any class that has exhibitors who have met the qualifying requirements. Exception: Individual awards for speed event classes and ranch horse classes will not be given. For those classes, a HIGH POINT and RESERVE SPEED EVENT, HIGH POINT and RESERVE RANCH HORSE awards will be given out in each division (Regular and Solid Paint Bred: Youth, Amateur and Open) to the horse with the highest cumulative state point total.

2018 MPHC MEMBERSHIP AND AWARDS POLICY

All Around High Point Awards

1. **Open, Open SPB** – Horse must compete in halter and three (3) performance classes under 16 of the 20 judges. Horse must show **three (3) times** in each qualifying class.
2. **Amateur Walk/Trot, Novice Amateur, Amateur, SPB Amateur** - (1 horse/1 rider) – Horse must show in halter and in three (3) performance classes under 16 of the 20 judges. Horse must show **three (3) times** in each qualifying class.
3. **Youth Walk Trot, Novice Youth, Youth 13/under, Youth 14-18, SPB Youth** – (1 horse/1 rider) – Horse **must** show in halter and in three (3) performance classes under 16 of the 20 judges. Horse must show **three (3) times** in each qualifying class.

ADDITIONAL RULES

1. Points earned in Overo and Tobiano Color classes will count for Weekend and Year End Awards. These Color Classes do not count toward the required Halter Class or three (3) performance classes per day.
2. Points earned at all Missouri Paint Horse Club sponsored shows AND Zone 5 horse show held between **March 1, 2018**, through **November 1, 2018**.
